

## WARNINGS AGAINST FALSE TEACHERS

Each book of the Brit Chadasha (New Testament) powerfully cautions the believer.

**Matthew 7: 21-23** Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. <sup>22</sup> On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?' <sup>23</sup> And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.

**Mark 13:22** For false messiahs and false prophets will rise and show signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

**Luke 21:8** See to it that you are not misled; for many will come in My name, saying, 'I am,' and, 'The time is near.' Do not go after them.

**John 10:1** *Truly, truly, I say to you, he who does not enter by the door into the fold of the sheep, but climbs up some other way, he is a thief and a robber.* 

Acts 20:29-30 "I know that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves men will arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them".

- **Rom.16:17-18** Now I urge you, brethren, note those who cause divisions and offenses, contrary to the doctrine which you learned, and avoid them. 18 For those who are such do not serve our Lord Yeshua the Messiah, but their own belly, and by smooth words and flattering speech deceive the hearts of the simple.
- **1Cor.15: 12** Now if Messiah is proclaimed as raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?
- **2Cor.11:12-14** 12 But what I do, I will also continue to do, that I may cut off the opportunity from those who desire an opportunity to be regarded just as we are in the things of which they boast. 13 For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into apostles of the Messiah. 14 And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light.
- **Gal.3:1-3** I O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you that you should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Messiah Yeshua was clearly portrayed among you as crucified? 2 This only I want to learn from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? 3 Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh?
- **Eph.4:14-15** that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, 15 but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Messiah—
- **Phil.3:1-2** Finally, my brethren, rejoice in the Lord. For me to write the same things to you is not tedious, but for you it is safe. 2 Beware of dogs, beware of evil workers, beware of the mutilation!
- **Col.2:8** Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Messiah.
- **1Thess.5:21** *Test all things; hold fast what is good.*
- **2Thess.2:1-3** Now, brethren, concerning the coming of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah and our gathering together to Him, we ask you, 2 not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as though the day of Messiah had come. 3 Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition.
- **1Tim.4:1-2** *1* Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons, 2 speaking lies in hypocrisy, having their own conscience seared with a hot iron."
- **2Tim.4:3-5** For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; 4 and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables. 5 But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

- **Titus 1:9-11,** 9 holding fast the faithful word as he has been taught, that he may be able, by sound doctrine, both to exhort and convict those who contradict. 10 For there are many insubordinate, both idle talkers and deceivers, especially those of the circumcision, 11 whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole households, teaching things which they ought not, for the sake of dishonest gain.
- **Heb.13:9** Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines. For it is good that the heart be established by grace, not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them.
- **James 3:1** Not many of you should become teachers, my brothers, for you know that we who teach will be judged with greater strictness.
- **1Pet.4:11** If anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Yeshua the Messiah, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.
- **2Pet.2:1-2** But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction. 2 And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed.
- **1Jn.2:26** *26 These things I have written to you concerning those who try to deceive you.*
- **2Jn.7** For many deceivers have gone out into the world who do not confess the Messiah Yeshua as coming in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.
- **3Jn.9** *I wrote to the church, but Diotrephes, who loves to have the preeminence among them, does not receive us.*
- **Jude 4** For certain men have crept in unnoticed, who long ago were marked out for this condemnation, ungodly men, who turn the grace of our God into lewdness and deny the only Lord God and our Lord Yeshua the Messiah.
- **Rev. 2:14** "But I have a few things against you, because you have there those who hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balak to put a stumbling block before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols, and to commit sexual immorality.
